## **Men of Hope Expected to Lead the Lanier Simpson Project for Community Restoration in Southwest Atlanta**

Boone Blvd., formerly known as Simpson Road. The area targeted for this project is a stretch of property down Joseph E. Boone, between Mason Turner Road and Lanier Street. An estimated 250 men are expected to participate. The ***Lanier Simpson Project*** provides an escort of safety, support, encouragement and renewal throughout the community.
